APPROACH:

eLearning Plus⁺ conducted an initial consultation to understand the scope and needs of the Client. Following this, we facilitated a first workshop as part of the eLearning Plus⁺ Strategic Learning Canvas Framework.

The workshop focused on:

- Understanding the business objectives, vision and the future direction and needs of the business
- Identifying the skills and capabilities required to deliver against the business objectives and future needs
- Evaluating the current skillset within the organisation to map out a strategic learning framework to address the identified gaps
- Addressing key challenges such as any risks and dependencies
- Scoping the project including timescales, budget, and priorities

OUTPUTS:

eLearning Plus⁺ developed a strategic framework report following the workshop. The report formed the foundation for the learning delivery programme.

The delivery programme is supporting the Client with implementing their new strategic learning framework in a way that meets the needs of individual learners as well as the business both now and into the future.
